Pool Use Agreement

Use of the St Joseph's School and Community Swimming Pool by the community and visitors has been approved by the Board of Trustees.

This is an unsupervised pool and the key holder, as a signatory to this agreement, must take full responsibility for all the pool users under their charge and comply with the following Code of Conduct. The Board of Trustees undertakes to provide a pool environment that complies with the current water safety and swim safe guidelines. Pool safety is paramount, any pool user that fails to comply with the code of conduct and if directed to by Chairperson of the Board of Trustee may have their key forfeited.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. During Term Time the pool is closed to the public between 8am and 3pm.
- 2. The Key Holder and those under their charge (ie part of their household) must comply with all signage at the pool (see overleaf).
- 3. The Key Holder must be 18 years or older. A Key Holder or other registered user 18 years or older must accompany any person under the age of 18 years.
- 4. The key user must take full responsibility for all persons that they admit into the pool.
- 5. Only appropriate swimwear may be worn in the pool. No ordinary clothes to be worn and no disposable napkins on toddlers (except Huggies "Little Swimmers"). Children MUST use the toilet BEFORE entering the pools and regularly while at the pool.
- 6. No food or drink allowed in the pool area. (Sipper bottles of water allowed). No glass.
- 7. No animals allowed in pool area.
- 8. No irresponsible behaviour will be tolerated in the pool area.
- 9. No smoking allowed in the pool area.
- 10. The Board of Trustees undertakes to provide a clean and safe pool environment and also to comply with the new Health and Safety Act, water quality and swim safe guidelines and therefore will be undertaking random safety checks of pool users.
 A Board member, the school care taker, a staff member or their approved agent(s) can request the following from the key holder or any person inside the pool grounds: their pool key number, the name of the registered user of that key, their address, d.o.b and proof of identity, the number of users and their age that are under their care and control.
- 11. Only registered Key Holders/Household Members or those accompanying them may use the pool. Keys must not be lent out of the Key Holders'/Users' possession. Keys may not be shared between families. Any person found abusing the key system may be banned from using the pool. If you bring visitors (outside your household family) please pay \$2 per visitor into the Honesty Box. You are responsible for their behaviour. Do not allow entry to people turning up at the door without a key.
- 12. Any key found in the possession on a non-signatory of this agreement must be surrendered immediately and the unauthorized user(s) must leave the pool immediately.
- 13. Damage, equipment failures, or urgent maintenance requirements (eg faecal accident) must be brought to the attention of a Board member or the school office immediately.

14. The key holder agrees that if they breach the code of conduct and if directed to by the Chairperson of the Board of Trustee or authorised Deputy they must return their key upon demand.
